



Mrs. Neal's Anatomy/Physiology—Lab and Activity Rules

The National Science Teachers Association recommends that students be informed of safety requirements for working in academic laboratories. This contract must be reviewed and signed prior to beginning any lab work.

1. **SAFETY** means **THINKING** at all times. Be aware of what you are doing at all times.
2. Always follow directions, and do only what is instructed.
3. Wear your lab apron and goggles at all times, unless otherwise instructed.
4. Absolutely no horseplay in the lab.
5. Report all spills and breakage to the teacher immediately.
6. Know the location of all safety and first aid equipment.
7. Complete all pre-lab reading and preparation before you begin.
8. Clean your lab station and put away all equipment when completed.
9. Be on the watch for unsafe conditions around the lab.
10. Anatomy is hands on, ears on, eyes on. There will be no excused work for missed labs (i.e. dissections)
11. All labs are due on the day they are assigned. There are NO DO-OVERS and no make-ups.
11. Never try an experiment at home based on any demonstration, experiment, or activity performed at school unless specifically assigned such an at-home lab.
- 12. Students creating unsafe conditions will lose their lab privileges and receive a zero for subsequent labs.**
